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YOUR PET'S SUMMER SAFETY

In the car, for instance, make sure window locks are on when driving with windows open. You don't want your dog's paw to inadvertently close the window. If you have indoor pets, try to keep their space as cool as possible by drawing shades, setting up fans or air conditioners safely, and supplying plenty of water. When exercising outdoors with your pet in the heat, consider its age and health. Avoid biking. When running, watch for signs of fatigue in the dog, and keep him or her hydrated.

And **BE SURE NEVER** to leave your pet confined in a car in the heat of summer. After all, you wouldn't want to remain in the hot sun for a long time without water or fresh air, and naturally neither does your pet. Be kind to your loyal and loving pet.
